- Specify and procure materials and products that strike a responsible balance between social, economic and environmental factors and generate benefits to society and the economy.
- Procure timber products directly or through our supply chain from recognised responsible sources such as FSC and PEFC.
- Procure timber with the longest lifespan wherever possible.
- Influence specify and source increasing amounts of materials which can be reused and recycled.
- Work with our approved waste-carrier to ensure that the majority of construction waste and office waste is recycled.
- Ensure that fair contract prices and terms are applied and respected, and that ethical, human rights and labour standards are met.
- Reduce Co2 Emissions by reducing distances travelled (where practicable) and procuring a more efficient fleet of company vehicles.
- Ensure compliance with relevant legislation and guidelines
